February Meeting Notes

Meeting started at 7:07pm

Attendance 15 Members

Treasurers Report was read and accepted

Old Business:

- Club dues are required by the March meeting. Unpaid members will not receive any further club correspondence until they are paid. Dues are \$15.00 per family.
- The trophies (picture frames) that Ernie was ordering fell through due to lack of stock from the vendor. Ernie presented a new picture frame as a replacement. The club approved Ernie to negotiate with the new vendor to try and reduce the cost of the new picture frame. Ernie will update the club at the March meeting regarding the status.
 - In regards to the trophies, the club discussed taking pictures of the cars as they show up and using that in the frames for the winners. How to print them, background, etc... was discussed but nothing was finalized. We will revisit the idea once we confirm that picture frames will be used.
- The car show location was discussed. Locations mentioned were Bayshore Drive, Sea Plane base, Chevy dealer, the lot near the Chamber of Commerce, Rite Aide parking lot, and City Beach. We will look at all options and present findings at the March meeting.
- Club Bylaws and rosters were available for all members present. If you have changes to the Bylaws to propose, bring them to the next meeting for the club to vote on. The Bylaws will be voted on next month with revisions or as currently written. Please ensure your information is correct on the roster and submit corrections as necessary.
- As we get new members, they will receive a copy of the Bylaws, a roster, cling/sticker, discount codes for partnership sites, and a membership card.
- The club voted to have the treasurer's monthly report be current balance only. An annual report will be available at the end of the year which will contain all account activity.

- In regards to the monthly club cruises, Joe recommended that we incorporate family events into the mix for members with children. The club agreed and will do so.
- The March cruise will be Saturday, March 13th to the Kangaroo Farm in Arlington. We will depart the Burlington McDonalds at 9:00am.
- The clings/stickers that the club approved in January are ordered and should be available to the members at the March meeting. To comply with the Bylaws, every member will receive their choice of one cling or sticker. The club also agreed to sell the clings/stickers for \$5.00 each. Thank you Brian for spearheading this.
- Brian also presented an estimate for vehicle magnets. They are die cuts of the club logo, 18"x18", and each will cost \$31.00 plus tax and shipping. The club approved the magnets and Brian agreed to head it up and will take orders from the members at the March meeting; this will ensure that we receive them before the Holland Happenings parade. If you wish to purchase some, ensure you bring your money to the March meeting.
- Paid members will be emailed the website discount codes for American Muscle and StangMods websites.

New Business:

- Joe researched getting polo shirts with the club logo embroidered on them. An example of the embroidering was presented and approved with changes by the members. The club voted to pay the set-up fee of \$75.00. The shirts will cost approximately \$25.00 each. Joe will provide more details as they become available. We expect to be able to order them next meeting.
- The Farmhouse asked us to renew our contract with them. They were requiring that we go down to a five item menu and a room purchase minimum of \$200.00. The club voted against this and voted to hold the March meeting at the Pizza Factory (947 Ault Field Rd.) in Oak Harbor. Other locations for subsequent meetings mentioned were the Oak Harbor Library, Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce, Oak Harbor School District bldg., San Remo Grill, Pizza Factory, Mi Pueblo, El Cazador, Flyers, Sweet Rice, Best Western conference room, and Coachman Inn conference room. We will try to nail down a permanent location by the March meeting. If you have any other suggestions for locations, bring them to the meeting with as many details as possible.
- Concerning the Chamber of Commerce, Brian mentioned that a silver membership with them costs \$275.00 annually, which includes free advertising on all chamber correspondence.
- The club voted on starting a Facebook page. Brian volunteered to maintain the site and the club approved.
- James is currently revising the club forms. They will be presented for approval by the club once completed.
- Welcome to our newest member, Keith Richards. He has a grey/tungsten 2006 Roush Stage R Mustang.
- A few members recommended changing the background colors behind the text to make it easier to read. James has for action.
- Rae explained reasoning behind last months email chain and stressed the importance of accurate club correspondence.
