There were 12 members attending

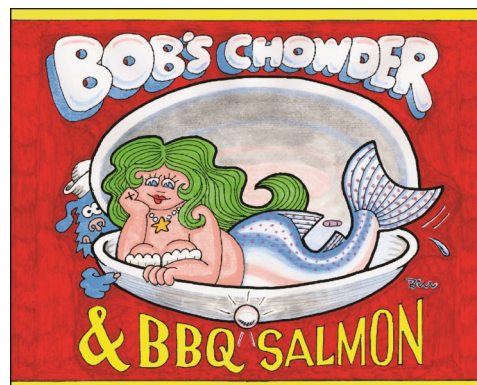
Old Business: . The GVMA show, Winthrop cruise and Arlington show were discussed.
